

RESOLUTION 4-18-2012

TOWNSHIP OF WATERFORD
RACINE COUNTY, WISCONSIN

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Township of Waterford at a special meeting dated April 18, 2012, does hereby pass and adopt the following resolution regarding the purchase of 56.92 acres at 28940 Fir Lane by the Department of Natural Resources.

Purpose: To object to the purchase of 28940 Fir Lane by the DNR within the Town of Waterford in order to prevent the creation of nuisances and to maintain the public health, safety and general welfare in accordance with the best interest of the Town of Waterford residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Town Board of the Township of Waterford does hereby adopt and enact the following resolution:

The Town Board of the Township of Waterford is against the Department of Natural Resources purchasing the property located at 28940 Fir Lane, Waterford, WI due to the following:

- A public access and parking lot should not be on a private road
- Walking trail maintenance/control buckthorn
- Policing (including but not limited to illegal parking, littering)
- Trash maintenance
- Safety
- Hunting too close to a residential neighborhood
- Traffic (North Tichigan Rd. cannot handle the additional traffic)
- Parking on private and town roads when lot is full or closed
- Illegal parking by ice fishermen
- Possible future Public Boat Launch
- No restroom facilities
- Town does not budget for nor maintain or plow private road
- Town would like the parking lot that currently exists on N. Lake Dr. and Halverson Rd. improved to provide the access needed to the Fir Ln. property
- Private owners of Fir Ln. would have to maintain and correct damage that would be created due to the added traffic.
- Public input and opposition in Town meetings and petitions
