

ORDINANCE#7-9-12

**TOWNSHIP OF WATERFORD
RACINE COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

**An Ordinance repealing and recreating Town of Waterford Ordinances
Section 6.03(6)(B) relating to the hours of operation of licensed retailers of
intoxicating liquors and fermented malt beverages within the Town of Waterford.**

THE TOWN BOARD, of the Township of Waterford, at its regular and duly-noticed monthly meeting, does hereby pass and adopt the following Ordinance repealing Town of Waterford Ordinances Section 6.03(6)(B) of the Town of Waterford Ordinances as recodified and revised May 13, 2003 and recreating Section 6.03(6)(B) to comply with changes in State law.

Purpose: To bring the Town of Waterford Ordinance relating to the hours of operation of licensed retailers of intoxicating liquors and fermented malt beverages within the Town of Waterford into compliance with recent changes in State law.

WHEREAS, the following changes to the Town of Waterford Ordinance relating to the hours of operation of licensed retailers of intoxicating liquors and fermented malt beverages within the Town of Waterford have been previously approved by the Town Board of the Town of Waterford,

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Township of Waterford does hereby repeal Section 6.03(6)(B) of the Town of Waterford Ordinances as recodified and revised May 13, 2003 and recreate Section 6.03(6)(B) to read:

B. Hours of Operation

1. No premises licensed for the sale of intoxicating liquor at retail shall, during the days or hours they are required to close, or during the hours in which the sale of liquor is prohibited, obstruct, by the use of curtains blinds, screens or in any other manner, a full and complete view of the interior from the outside. During the hours in which the sale of intoxicating liquors is permitted the premises shall be properly and adequately lighted.

2. It is the intention of the Town Board that the hours of operation of licensed retailers of intoxicating liquors and fermented malt beverages within the Town of Waterford comply with applicable State law and not be more restrictive than the same. No premises for which an alcohol beverage license has been issued shall remain open and/or sell alcohol beverages during the hours listed below:

“Class A”, Liquor	9:00 p.m. – 6:00a.m.	Not permitted
“Class B”, Liquor	12:00 a.m. – 6:00 a.m.	Mon. – Fri. 2:00 a.m. – 6:00 a.m. Sat. – Sun. 2:30 a.m. – 6:00 a.m.
“Class A”, Fermented Malt Beverage	12:00 a.m. – 6:00 a.m.	Not permitted
“Class B”, Fermented Malt Beverage	12:00 a.m. – 6:00 a.m.	Mon. – Fri. 2:00 a.m. – 6:00 a.m. Sat. – Sun. 2:30 a.m. – 6:00 a.m.

In addition to the hours listed above, the following special closing hours apply to Class B Liquor and Class B Fermented Malt Beverage licensees:

- Second Sunday in March: 3:30 a.m. – 6:00 a.m.
- New Years Eve: no closing required

Nothing in this ordinance shall be deemed to exempt licensees within the Town of Waterford from any other applicable restrictions imposed on the sale of intoxicating liquors and fermented malt beverages by the State of Wisconsin.

PASSED AND ADOPTED this 9th day of July, 2012, to take effect upon posting and / or publication as required by law.
