SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING FOR WATERFORD APPROVED/OFFICIAL MINUTES FOR AUGUST 10, 2015 5:00 PM AT TOWN HALL

Special Town Board meeting was called to order at 5:00 PM by Chairman Hincz. Present: Supervisors: Alvey, Draskovich, Gauerke and Szeklinski. Also present was Chief Tom Ditscheit and applicant, Mark Sorenson.

Chief Ditscheit introduced Mark Sorenson. Sorenson has been with Racine County Sheriff since 1986 with 12 years as a detective. He has also been in both the drug and gang units and plans to retire in 2016. Chairman Hincz indicated that Mr. Sorenson comes highly recommended. Commissioner Luick noted that he was impressed with Sorenson's experience with the drug and gang units. Town Board went on to interview Mr. Sorenson. Supervisor Szeklinski motioned to hire Mark Sorenson as a part-time officer with the applicant being aware of potential layoffs as well as a one year probation, seconded by Supervisor Draskovich. Vote taken: 5-0. Motion carried.

Chairman Hincz indicated that another applicant had applied but has taken a full-time job at another police department.

Supervisor Szeklinski motioned to adjourn the meeting at 5:25 am, seconded by Supervisor Draskovich. All in favor 5-0. Motion carried.
