

As most of you are aware, the State of Wisconsin recently went through a redistricting process which, in the case of the Town of Waterford, affected our State Senator and Representative to the Assembly. In the past, the whole Town was in District 28 for Senator and District 83 for Representative. This is no longer the case. Only a small portion of the Town will continue to be in these districts. The majority of the Town will now be in District 21 for Senator and District 62 for Representative. The best and easiest way to break down the old districts vs the new districts is: those voters west of Buena Park Rd. will remain in the original districts, those to the east of Buena Park Rd. will be in the new districts. I have not been supplied a map so there may be some areas that don't fall directly in this pattern.

To determine/confirm your district, I **strongly** encourage voters to visit www.myvote.wi.gov.



Click on “What’s on my ballot”. You will be able to determine your district by scrolling through this page. You can also check using the following link so that you can search by address:

Because of these changes, voting will look a little different (only during elections for State Senator and Representative). When you come in you will now be divided by Districts as we will now have two pollbooks. As I already mentioned, the majority of voters will be in districts 21 and 62. Only a small fraction of voters will remain in districts 28 and 83. Please check out your district so you aren't waiting in the wrong line. This is all new to you as well as the Election staff so please be patient and determine your district before coming to the polls.
