- Providing full depth pulverize, grading, shaping, and 4-inch asphalt paving for 3500 LF of Territorial Drive from Pleasant Road to Caldwell Drive;
- Providing full depth pulverize, grading, shaping, and 4-inch asphalt paving for 1000 LF of Riverside Road from South of Bridge to 4525 Riverside;
- Providing full depth removal, shaping and 4-Inch asphalt relay for 1050 LF of Mountain Lane;
- Providing full depth pulverize, grading, shaping, and 4-inch asphalt paving for 630 LF of lake Pointe Court;

Bidders shall submit Bids online through QuestCDN.com. Bidders should pay attention to the requirements for Bid signatures, as set forth in Bid Security. Bidders may not withdraw their Bids within the 90-day period after the date of the Bid Opening

The Town will only consider Bids from Bidders who accompany them with a Bid Bond, payable to the Town of Waterford, in the amount equal to 5 percent of the Bid. This requirement serves to guarantee that, if the Town accepts the Bid, the selected Contractor will execute and deliver the proper Contract Agreement and Bonds within 15 calendar days after the Notice of Award. Failure to return these documents within this prescribed time will result in forfeiture, to the Town of Waterford, of the selected Bid Bond, as liquidated damages.
